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Vision Zero Houston

Collecting and analyzing crash data

- **We found:** nearly 60% of traffic deaths and serious injuries occur on just 6% of streets in Houston (High Injury Network).

Community engagement

- **We're asking:** what do safe streets mean to you? Where do you feel unsafe walking, driving, biking, and using a wheelchair? Which actions should the City take first to improve street safety?

Developing action items

- **We're using:** community feedback, input from Vision Zero committees and stakeholders, and crash data to inform measurable actions

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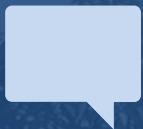
