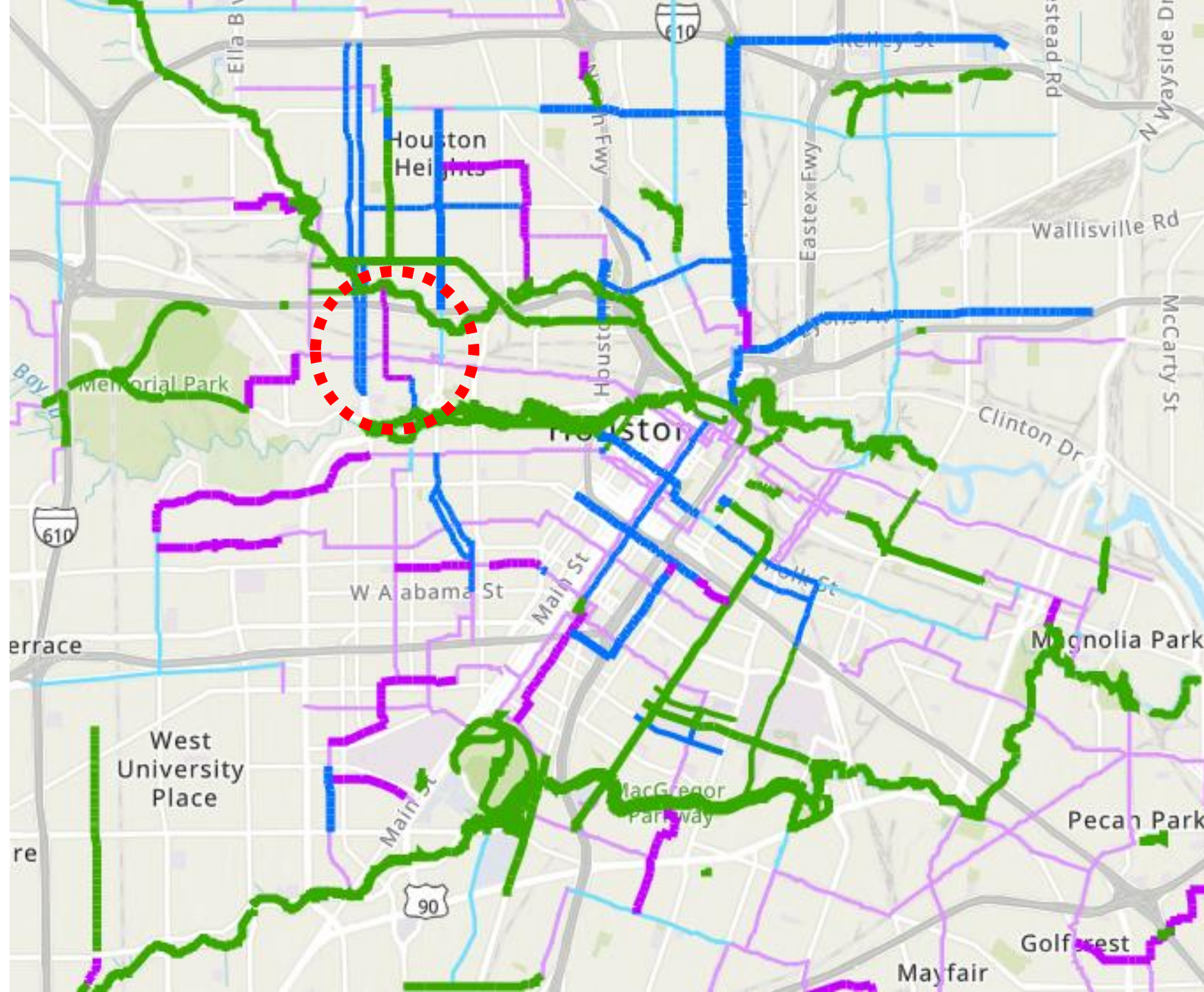
Project History

- SN22 Transportation Plan (2010)
Identified Patterson as priority bicycle connection
- Washington Avenue Livable Centers Study (2013)
Identified Patterson as priority bicycle connection
- Houston Bike Plan (2017)
Lists Patterson as “short-term retrofit”
- Safer Streets Initiative (2018)
Washington/Patterson intersection studied in recent Road Safety Audit

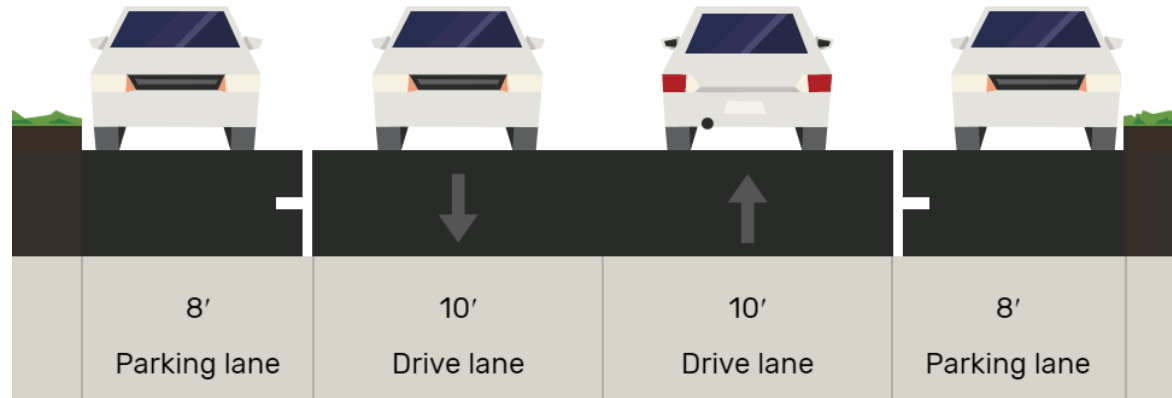

- Jan. 2020: Pop-up Bike Lane on Jackson Hill

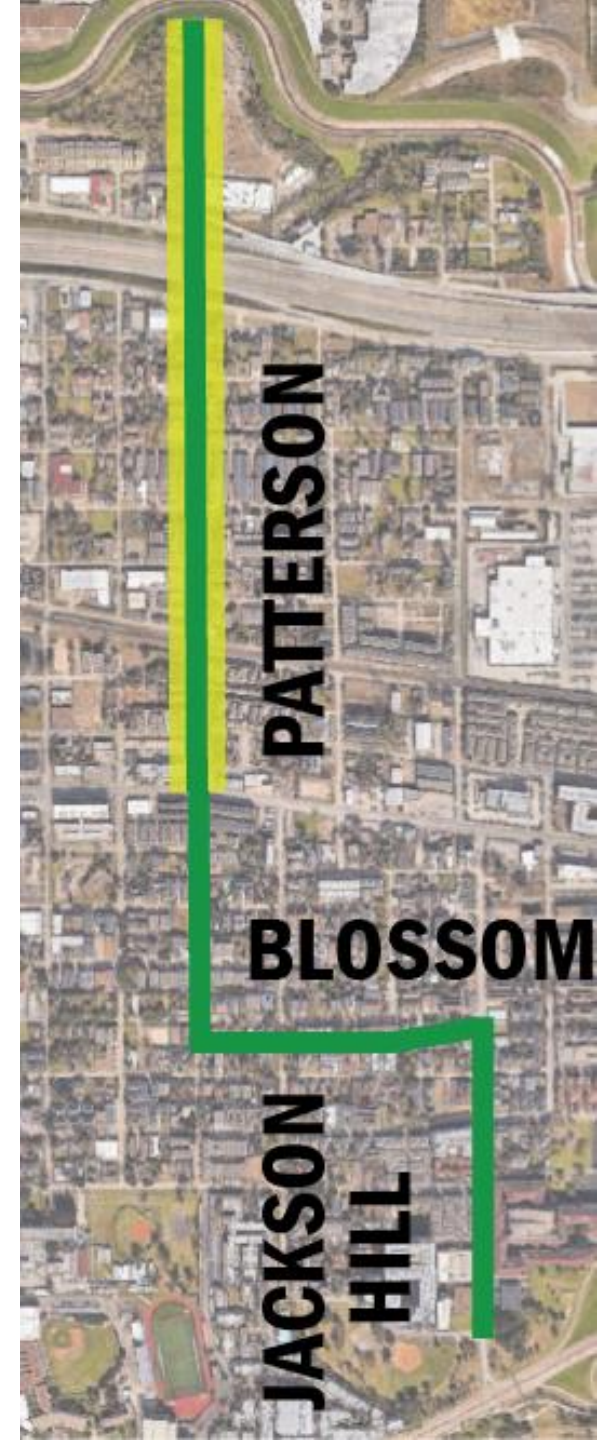
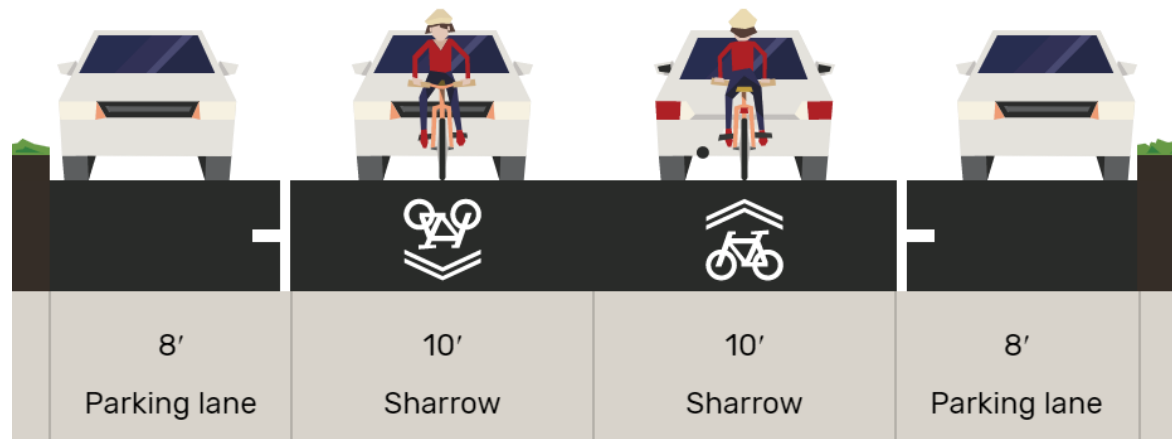


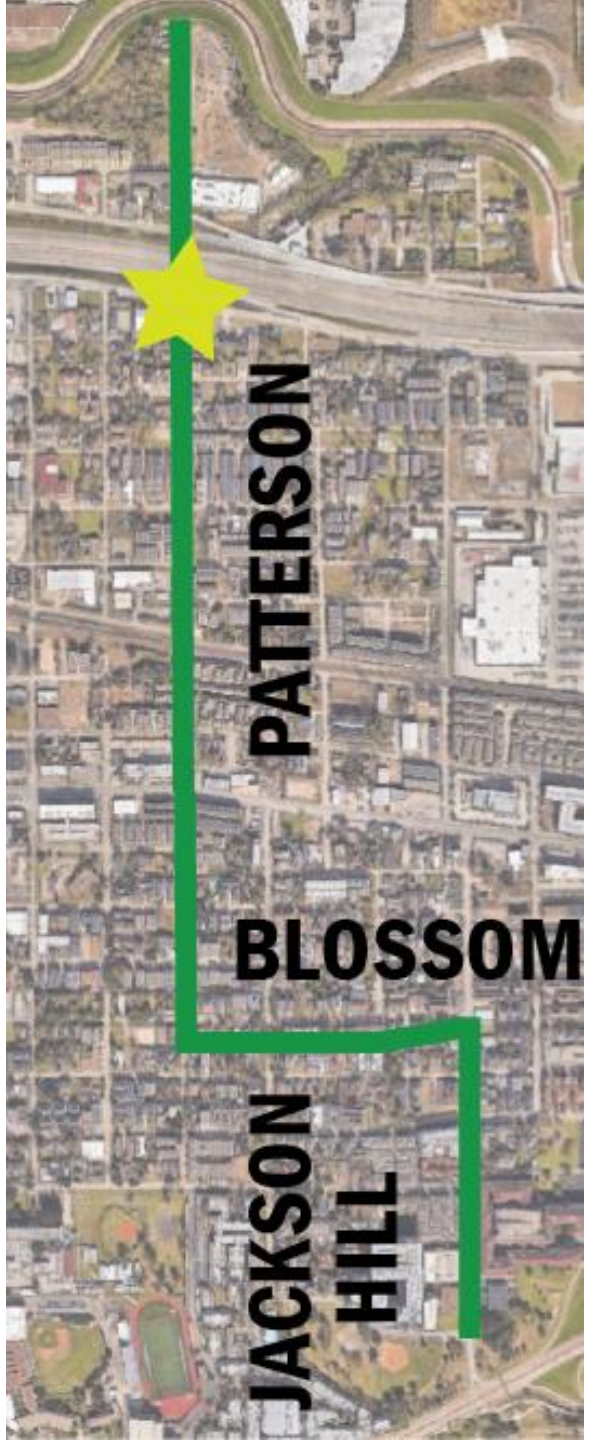
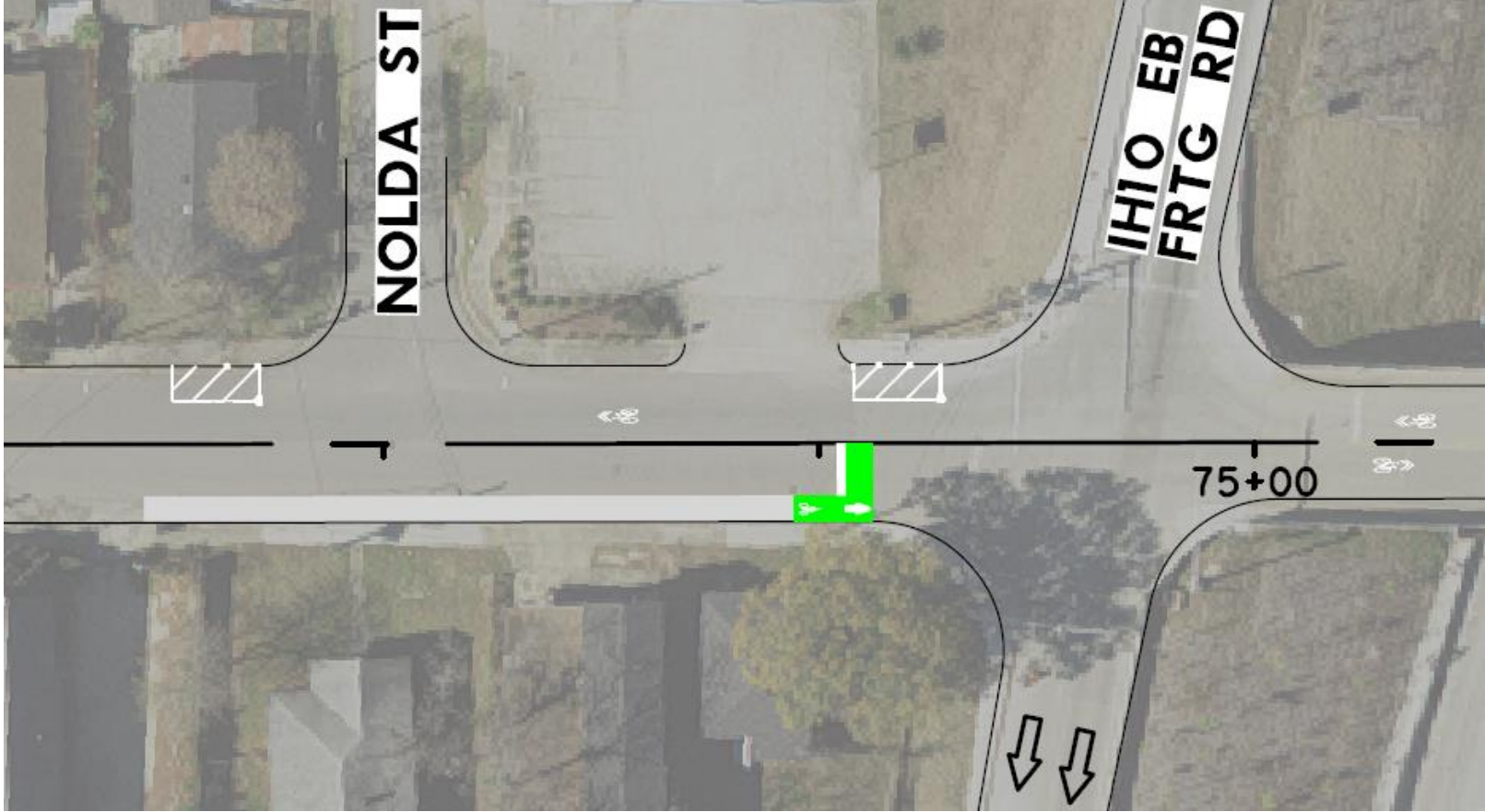


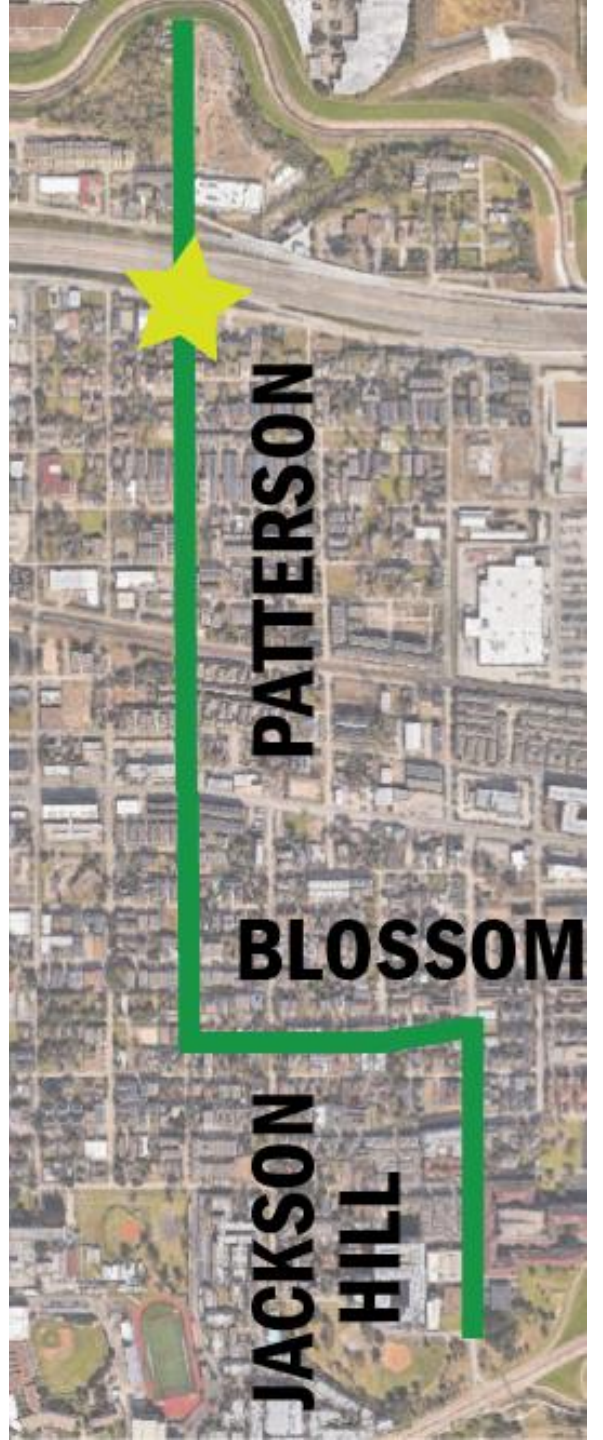
