

- Community provided comments











Proposed Street Section

Transition Points





All-way stop at Glen Park/North





New Development in the Area

- Still under construction
- Sharp curve on North Main
- White Oak Music Hall Events
- Increased traffic



NORTH MAIN STREET – BIKE LANE

Bicycle Lanes

- Considered growth from development in traffic counts
- Roadway has capacity to absorb new trips
- The bicycle lane will help accommodate growth



NORTH MAIN STREET – BIKE LANE

Future Traffic Demand

- North Main is built – we can't widen the road
- Use existing Right of Way to provide multimodal options
- People are already cycling in the area
 - Some are by choice and others don't have options
 - This community has been divided by the freeway
- We are ensuring safe mobility options for the future



NEXT STEPS

- Continued Public Engagement
- 100% Design Completion
- Timeline
 - Contractor on board
 - 3-5 months to complete construction
