Item 1: Director's Report. Jennifer Ostlind. No updates at this time.

Item 2: Chair's Report. Chair Joe Cutrufo gave the Chair's Report.

Bikeway projects funded for design and construction on pause. Houston has an obligation to build streets that are safe for everyone. The Shepherd/Durham project is in recent news, and has broad support from the public, elected officials, developers, etc. The project will install bike infrastructure at the highest standard.

More than 80 people have been killed while riding bicycles on Houston streets since 2017 when the Houston Bike Plan was adopted. None of these fatalities occurred on segments with bikeways separate from traffic. The work that has been coming through the BAC is saving lives and improving public safety.

City Council voted this morning to sell a piece of the White Oak Bayou Greenway to TxDOT as part of the North Houston Highway Improvement Project. We can expect detours during construction; I hope the City, Houston Parks Board, and TxDOT are working together to get people safely around this project. This isn't just a recreational bike trail: it's a high volume trail for bike commuters too.

Item 3: Public Comment.

Item 4: Bikeways Budget Overview.

Brian D. Smith II, Transportation Planner, Planning & Development, presented an overview of the Houston Bikeways budget as executed through the CIP.

Item 5: Bikeway Maintenance/Sweeper Updates.

Brian D. Smith II, Transportation Planner, Planning & Development, presented an update on the bikeways sweeping program. Unfortunately, the Space City Sweeper will sunset due to continuous breakdowns. HPW is currently exploring options for another sweeper. The 311 bikeway-specific maintenance category is online, but currently only on the website.

Item 6: Open Forum.

Alejandro Perez: response to selling of White Oak Bayou trail segment; focus on maintenance; shifting to off-street trails.

Tom Compson: request update on BAC appointments or reappointments.

Trevor Reichman: BAC's role as an advisory committee in lieu of the pause in projects.

Staff Update: Bikeways Mileage Data:

Total Bikeway Mileage: 432 miles

Completed in 2023: 26 miles (13 dedicated on-street, 2 shared on-street, 11 off-street)

Currently programmed: 112 miles (49 dedicated on-street, 7 shared on-street, 56 off-street)

Last year was the first year we built more on-street facilities than off-street.

Alejandro Perez: any updates on Mayor's Office review of bikeways projects; strategic bikeways funds.

Robin Holzer: asked about any contractual agreements/timelines for bikeways projects not completely owned by the City and done with partners.

Trevor Reichman: asked for more detail on who is reviewing the bikeways projects.

Alejandro Perez: asked on Bryan Dotson's behalf on leveraging Cullen Park Path/Piping Rock projects
