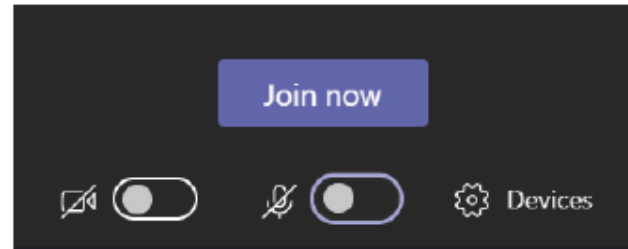

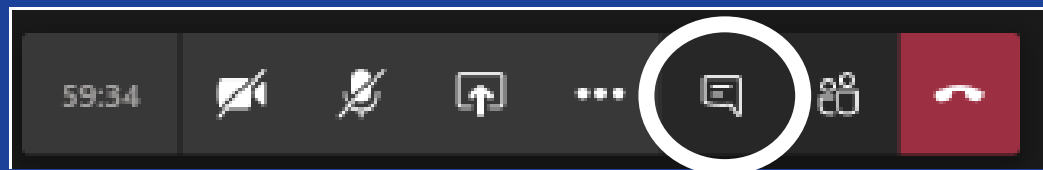

The **Idaho stop** is the informal name for a law that allows cyclists to treat a stop sign as a yield sign, and in some places, a red light as a stop sign.

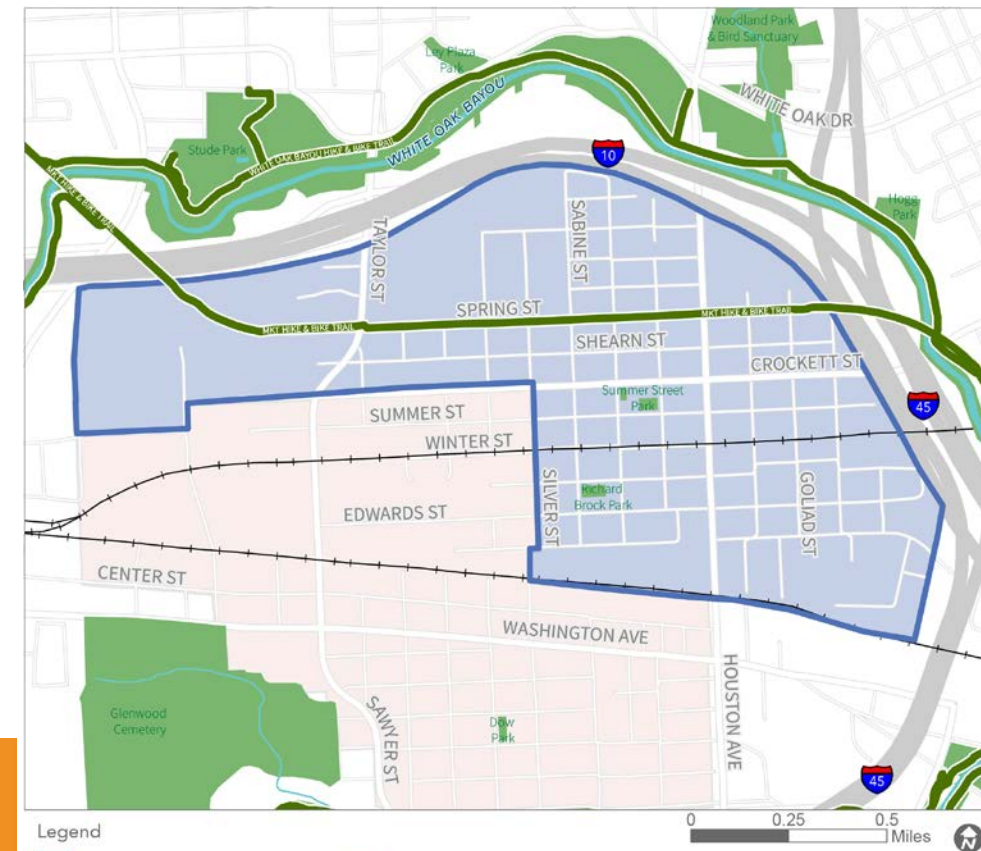
